## INSTRUCTIONS FOR ENTRY

### 2020 Sit Down Shutup and Watch Film & New Media Festival

Sit Down Shutup and Watch is Australia's premier learning disability-led film festival celebrating films and new media made by people with a learning disability.

#### Eligibility

The Lead Creative Person for the film must be a person who identifies with learning disability or autism. The Lead Creative's role could be anything (script writer, actor, director, producer, camera operator etc) but they must be the key contributor to the film.

If the film is created by a group working collaboratively across all roles, more than half of the group must identify with learning disability or autism.

Non-disabled people can act as the Facilitator and give support and advice to the Lead Creative or the group.

#### Requirements for films

- This is primarily a short film festival but the required length is flexible
- All films must have English subtitles, for accessibility.
- You must have permission in writing to use all the music, sound and images of people in your film.
- We will not accept any films that are offensive, obscene or contrary to law.

Films should be submitted in the following format:

- File type - .MOV files
- Compression - H.264
- Ratio format - 1920 x 1080p
- Colour encoding system - PAL
